and low torsional resistance which is
different from other cottons.*





Algodon Nativo grows naturally in many beautiful colors such as cream, green, brown, purple, white and beige. Due to this array of colors it unlikely to be used in mass production as white is the preferred natural color of cottons. These industrialized cottons are selected and bioengineered for pest resistance and for their pure white color which makes it easier to dye.
